



Knights of Columbus, Council 6429 Scholarship Guidelines & Application

For the 2018/19 School year, the Knights of Columbus will be offering (3) Scholarships of equal value. The net proceeds from the “Fat Friday” Dinner will be split equally across the (3) Scholarships. A minimum of \$2,000 total pool or \$667 per scholarship will be awarded. If net proceeds from the Fat Friday Dinner exceed \$2,000, the scholarships value will be pro-rated accordingly. (Example if the Fat Friday Dinner net proceeds = \$2,700 then (3) scholarships of \$900 will be awarded).

Eligibility:

1. 8th grade students graduating from St. Columbkille or Religious Education Students at St Columbkille who chose to attend a Catholic High School.

Requirements:

1. Letter of Recommendation from someone in the community other a teacher or family member (written in the **third person** to keep identity of applicant unknown, i.e. using **Student** in place of students name).
2. Be involved in at least two organized extra--curricular activities during this past year.
3. Have completed at least 30 community service hours this past year. Explain what service was and show verification that they were completed. (Signed by someone other than a parent or guardian).
4. Essay (Written by student) “Why you feel a Catholic education is important”, again, writing so you remain anonymous.

All applications should be turned in to St. Columbkille School or Religious Education Office no later than **3:15 PM, Friday, May 4, 2018**. The application will then be forwarded to the selection committee. The selected applicants will be notified by the selection committee.
