SCHOOL ILLNESS

We have confirmed cases of Influenza A and Strep, and lots of fevers, sore throats, headaches, and stomach troubles. We need your help! If your children aren't feeling well, and especially if they have a fever or any of the symptoms listed above, please keep them home. It will help to stop the spread of germs and keep the rest of the student body healthy! We ask that you review the information below from the Sarpy/Cass County Health Department and the Center for Disease Control and follow their recommendations:

- **Please protect others, your children and yourself with a flu shot.**
- **If they can't afford a flu shot Midlands Hospital has the Vaccines for Children Program that will give the shot for free.**
- **Staff/students should stay home if ill and not return to school until they are 24hrs fever free.**
- **Stay away from people who have been ill.**
- **No Tylenol/ibuprofen to mask the fever and send child to school.**
- **Keep hands away from mouth, nose, and eyes.**
- **Wash hands/cover cough, discard tissue in waste basket, and wash hands again.**

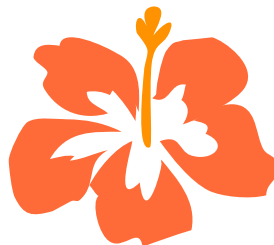

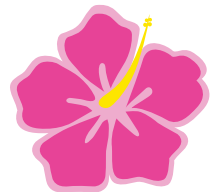
