May 8, 2018 H.S.A. Meeting Minutes (35 attendees)

Kelli Krause called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the group in an opening prayer.

Kelli thanked Sara Yarpe for running the Teacher Appreciation week and Susie Nelson for her support in running the Mother Son Dodgeball event. She also thanked all the other countless volunteers.

Kelli talked about the Flower Sale and Lemonade Sale on Saturday May 12<sup>th</sup>. Thank you to Rita Weiss for all your efforts with the Flower Sale.

David Moline gave the Treasurer Report. H.S.A. provide \$3,100 to the 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Youth Frontiers Retreat. For the May Flower sales, we brought in \$3700 but we still need to pay Papio Valley Nursery for the flowers, so our net income is to be determined. H.S.A. plans to replace the iPads. We will fund improved security for the school and we're still in the process of evaluating the bids. Additionally, H.S.A. is providing \$1,000 to two St. Columbkille 8<sup>th</sup> grades who plan to attend a Catholic high school. H.S.A. is also providing one \$500 college scholarship to a St. Columbkille School alumni who will enter college next year.

Stewardship Report: Chris discussed restaurant night proceeds. For the recent Chick Fil A night, the school earned \$156. The grand total for the 2017-18 school year restaurant nights is \$2,051. Additionally, we received funds for the Papio Bowl night (\$189) and the [Shoparoo](#) App (\$100).

Principal's Report: Mrs. Redburn thanked the departing HSA members for their service this year. Mrs. Redburn then introduced Dick Van Haute who discussed the Church's [Capital Campaign](#).

H.S.A. will lead a school float for the Papillion Day Parade on June 16<sup>th</sup>. We will have one final restaurant night in late June at the HyVee Cafe. The exact date of this event will be announced in the near future.

Thank you to the Uniform Exchange volunteers, Kara Wesley and Kayla Uptmor. We're looking for two people to take over the Uniform Exchange for next year.

Kelli discussed the open positions for next year. We have four candidates for four positions. Kelli asked if anyone else was interested in any of the positions. Since there was one candidate for each vacancy, no vote was required. Amanda Jensen will be the new H.S.A. Stewardship Director. Jennifer Wright will be Treasurer. Kara Wesley will be Secretary. Kristin Steenson will be Vice President for next year (2018-19) and will be HSA President for the 2019-20 school year. Congratulations to our new H.S.A. board members!

Diane Ferro, oncoming HSA President presented a memento and said some words of thanks to our very dedicated H.S.A. president Kelli Krause. We all thank Kelli for her countless hours of hard work in leading HSA over the past two years. Thank you Kelli!
