January 8, 2019 H.S.A. Meeting Minutes

In addition, the HSA vice president position for 2019-2020 is open. The election for this position will be held at the May HSA meeting. Jennifer Wright gave the treasurer's report. The HSA has funded new textbooks, faculty conference(s), and security system upgrades.

Amanda Jensen provided a Stewardship update on Jimmy Johns and Creation Station. Creation Station had a wonderful turnout. Upcoming events are at Panera (Wednesday, January 16), Urban Air (Thursday, January 17), Daddy Daughter Dance (January 20), Don & Millie's (February 7), and Raising Cane's (February 27). The Principal's Report was presented by Mrs. Redburn. Mrs. Redburn shared that kindergarten mailers were sent to new potential families. Online registration for all families opens on February 5. There will be a two-week window to get your child(ren)'s enrollment information updated. Pre-school enrollment will also open soon. New facility construction will start after the end of this school year and will impact the pre-school location for the 2019-2020 school year. Terra Nova test results will be sent home the week of January 7. Mrs. Redburn and Mrs. Foreman will use the Terra Nova and MAP test data to set school improvement goals for next school year.
