### February 28, 2017 H.S.A. Meeting Minutes

Kelli Krause called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with an opening prayer. We enjoyed an outstanding performance by the Crusingers, our St Columbkille 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade show choir.

Kelli discussed the vacant HSA Vice President that will open for next year. This is a two year term...the first year is served as the vice president and the second year is served as president. If interested, please talk with Kelli or one of the H.S.A. staff members.

The Daddy Daughter Dance was a success. A big thanks to Jessica Rempe for leading the effort, and for all the mothers who volunteered to help.

Mother Son Dodge Ball Event is Sun Apr 9, 2 to 4pm. There will be 'crafts, football toss competition & photo booth' as part of Mother-Son Dodgeball activities. Pizza and cookies will be served.

School Supply Service – Kelli explained this service, which would allow parents to order school supplies without having to go out and shop. After voting, only 1 or 2 were interested.

Treasurer's Report with Dave Moline – The Daddy Daughter Dance made a couple hundred dollars. HSA has \$55,000 in cash currently.

Stewardship update with Chris Williams – Made \$295 from Panera night. Chili's check is not in yet. Jimmy John's will be March 7<sup>th</sup>. From 4 to 9pm. St C gets 15% of your total purchase. This is the Jimmy John's location near the Dunkin Donuts near 72<sup>nd</sup> and Cornhusker. We're looking for volunteers to help coordinate some of the HSA stewardship activities next year.

Family April 28<sup>th</sup> is the Family Drive-In Night. We'll be showing Wreck-It Ralph. We'll have a car decorating contest for families with a small prize for the winner. Food will be hot dog, nachos, etc. Anyone interested in helping should see Chris Williams.

Spring Flower Sale – Rita Weiss talked about the Flower Sale Fundraiser for the weekend of May 14<sup>th</sup> – They will be offering several varieties of flowers and vegetables (including Roma Tomatoes). These come from a supplier in Kansas. We used the same supplier last year and had nearly 100% order fulfillment. There are multiple types available, including hanging baskets. We will be looking for
