I will not be able to attend the meeting due to another commitment.

1. We are currently looking at a deficit of approximately \$79,800 in our parish budget so have asked that each staff member, including the school try to cut 1 % to 2% so that we are closer to meeting budget we must present to the Archdiocese.
2. Our parish is considered a Stewardship Parish. In some ways we are doing a great job in this area and in some ways we are lacking. A team from our parish attended a Stewardship Conference in Wichita KS and will be working hard to promote the Stewardship life style. More information to come.
3. As most should already know Mr. Makey is retiring and Mrs. Redburn will be our new principal.
4. A big **THANK YOU** to all our parishioners for completing the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey. It's designed to provide an opportunity for our parishioners to reflect on their spiritual growth and their engagement within our parish.
