
OVERVIEW

The Steubenville Youth Conference is a three-day experience consisting of music, keynote speakers, small group time, breakout sessions, Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, fellowship, and fun!

The majority of the conference takes place in a large-group setting, but teens will also spend time in small groups of 7-8 people of the same gender with at least one adult leader. Youth attending from our parish will meet in small groups together.

THE BASICS

WHERE & WHEN...This year we will attend Steubenville of the Rockies in Denver, Colorado. The Conference will take place June 21-23. We will be traveling separately from the Archdiocesan group that is again attending the STL Conference in July.



TRANSPORTATION, TIMING, & ACCOMMODATIONS...This depends a great deal on how many people we have register. My hope is that we will have enough students to travel by bus (~25 students). If not, we will ask chaperones to drive groups of students.

We will leave early Friday morning, likely by 7:00. We will return following closing Mass on Sunday. Allowing time for a couple stops and dinner, we should return around 10 p.m.

The conference is held at a hotel, but the number of attendees is larger than the hotel can hold. As such, we will be assigned a hotel – possibly onsite, but we don't know that yet. If not onsite, we will travel to and from the conference site as a group each morning and each evening.
